To ensure eligibility for our adult education and training services, students are required to complete a pre-assessment during the registration process. For eligible individuals seeking Catholic Charities' educational services, there is an additional step to apply for training funds through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) adult program. Prospective trainees will receive comprehensive support from both Catholic Charities personnel and NM Workforce career specialists to help them complete and submit their funding applications.
